

Study Abroad Program Types

Northwestern offers a variety of study abroad programs, including:

- Northwestern Programs** – Students enroll directly at the local university.
- Exchange Programs** – Students enroll at a partner university and receive credit from Northwestern.
- Faculty-Led Programs** – Faculty members lead small groups of students to study abroad.
- Language Programs** – Programs designed to help students learn a new language.
- Research Programs** – Programs that allow students to conduct research abroad.
- Service Programs** – Programs that combine study with community service.
- Internship Programs** – Programs that provide students with hands-on experience in a field.
- Study Abroad for one quarter as part of a degree program** – Students can study abroad for one quarter as part of their degree program.
