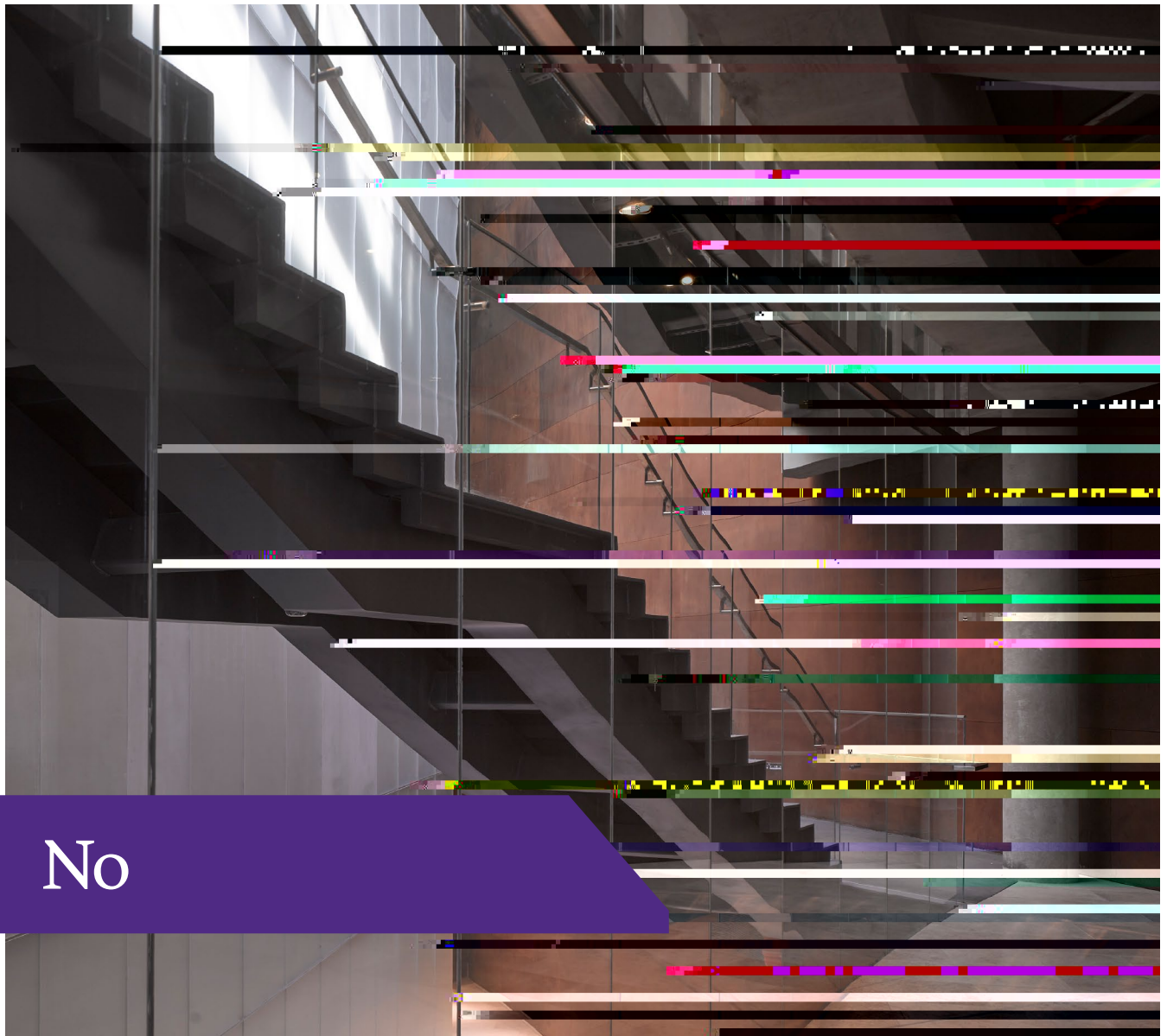

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## Orders of Protection or Restraining Orders

1. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of domestic violence against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of domestic violence against the petitioner.

2. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual assault against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of sexual assault against the petitioner.

3. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of stalking against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of stalking against the petitioner.

4. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of harassment against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of harassment against the petitioner.

## Information and Options for Survivors of Sexual Misconduct Abroad

1. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual misconduct against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of sexual misconduct against the petitioner.

2. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual harassment against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of sexual harassment against the petitioner.

3. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of sexual assault against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of sexual assault against the petitioner.

## Miscellaneous

1. The court may issue an order of protection or restraining order if the respondent has committed an act of domestic violence against the petitioner, or if the respondent has threatened to commit an act of domestic violence against the petitioner.

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# Appendix B

## Clery Act Crimes and Clery Act Geography Definitions

### Clery Act Crimes

(1) (a) (i) (A) Rape: The offense of rape is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual intercourse with another person under any of the following circumstances:

- (1) The offender knows or recklessness that the victim is unconscious or is otherwise incapacitated by alcohol or drugs, is physically helpless, or is otherwise unable to consent to the act.
- (2) The offender knows or recklessness that the victim does not consent to the act.

(B) Sexual Assault: The offense of sexual assault is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual contact with another person under any of the following circumstances:

- (1) The offender knows or recklessness that the victim is unconscious or is otherwise incapacitated by alcohol or drugs, is physically helpless, or is otherwise unable to consent to the act.
- (2) The offender knows or recklessness that the victim does not consent to the act.

(C) Incest: The offense of incest is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual intercourse with another person who is a close relative of the offender.

(D) Child Abuse: The offense of child abuse is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual contact with a minor child.

(E) Stalking: The offense of stalking is defined as the intentional or recklessness course of conduct that causes a victim to fear for their safety or the safety of another person.

(F) Sexual Exploitation: The offense of sexual exploitation is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual contact with another person for the purpose of financial gain or other benefit.

(G) Sexual Harassment: The offense of sexual harassment is defined as the intentional or recklessness conduct that is based on sex and that creates a hostile or abusive environment.

(H) Intimidation: The offense of intimidation is defined as the intentional or recklessness threat of violence or other harm against a victim.

(I) Physical Assault: The offense of physical assault is defined as the intentional or recklessness use of force or violence against another person.

(J) False Information: The offense of false information is defined as the intentional or recklessness dissemination of false information that causes a victim to believe that they are in danger.

(K) Identity Theft: The offense of identity theft is defined as the intentional or recklessness use of another person's identity for financial gain or other benefit.

(L) Hate Crime: The offense of hate crime is defined as the intentional or recklessness commission of a crime motivated by bias against a victim's race, gender, or ethnicity.

(M) Domestic Violence: The offense of domestic violence is defined as the intentional or recklessness commission of a crime against a family member or intimate partner.

(N) Stalking: The offense of stalking is defined as the intentional or recklessness course of conduct that causes a victim to fear for their safety or the safety of another person.

(O) Sexual Exploitation: The offense of sexual exploitation is defined as the intentional or recklessness sexual contact with another person for the purpose of financial gain or other benefit.

(P) Sexual Harassment: The offense of sexual harassment is defined as the intentional or recklessness conduct that is based on sex and that creates a hostile or abusive environment.

(Q) Intimidation: The offense of intimidation is defined as the intentional or recklessness threat of violence or other harm against a victim.

(R) Physical Assault: The offense of physical assault is defined as the intentional or recklessness use of force or violence against another person.
